- Flight inspections, including required pre-inspection checks.
- Maintenance activities supporting the 56-day and 28-day chart updates.
- Scheduled interruptions in direct support of a runway or taxiway that is closed due to construction or required airport authority/sponsor maintenance.

- Strategic Event Coordination (SEC) long-term scheduled interruptions that have begun before the start of the moratorium period.

- Taking as-found readings on systems administratively removed from service by the Technical Operations Aircraft Accident Representative (TOAAR).

- Maintenance activities required in order to assist NAS Cyber Operations (NCO) with identification or remediation of NAS cyber events.

## **Risk Management/Assessment**

The final release of a system or service remains dependent upon Control Center coordination, Air Traffic approval, and current operational conditions. Even with an approved waiver, Operational Risk Management (ORM) assessments of maintenance activities are still required as part of normal coordination procedures during moratorium periods. This Maintenance Alert provides the direction and guidelines for the national-level maintenance moratorium restrictions during the moratorium periods; Technical Operations Directors and local District and Group Managers maintain the authority to institute further, more stringent maintenance moratorium restrictions within their area of responsibility.

Maintenance that is rescheduled due to moratorium restrictions should be scheduled and completed as soon as possible, either before the start or after the end of the moratorium period. Per the guidance in Order 6000.15, General Maintenance Handbook for NAS Facilities, and Order JO 6040.15, National Airspace Performance Reporting Service (NAPRS), any periodic maintenance (PM) not performed as a result of the maintenance moratorium should be logged in SAL as a Code Category 55 PM Not Performed, Supplemental Code 0-Other or Null, Maintenance Action Code (MAC): M-Maintenance Moratorium.

## **Submitting Waivers**
