Dear Mr. Wachter:

In response to your letter regarding the above and our recent briefing we respectively submit the following: PASS makes the following negotiable proposals as a result of the impacts on Flight Standards bargaining unit employees:

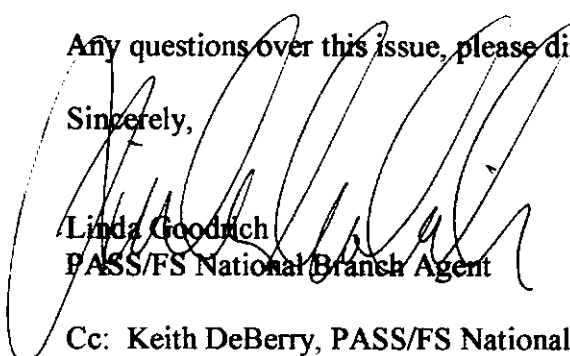
1. All assigned Organization Management Team (OMT) members of all Flight Standards bargaining unit members (BUE) will be selected on a seniority basis based upon equally qualified individuals.
2. Any BUE assigned to an OMT, will be compensated at the same rate of pay of the highest OMT member on the team.
3. The assignment to an OMT will be a 2 year temporary assignment.
4. The team member must have 5 years with the FAA to serve and bid on an OMT. In the event the agency changes the requirement for the industry ODA to have 5 years experience, the agency will change the experience requirement for the agency OMT member.
5. All BUE assigned OMT members will attend the same Designee seminar at the same time. The cost of agency bargaining unit member attending these FAA seminars and briefings and travel will be paid for by the Agency.
6. The complexity points or value associated with this assignment; due to the importance and/or complexity will increase commiserate with a full time equivalent assignment at the appropriate pay rate; regardless of size of OMT or ODA.
7. That the BUE not considered due to experience requirements set by the agency, the agency will provide skills and/or experience lacking in writing to the BUE, upon request. The agency will also provide the opportunity to obtain said experience, upon request through their PMS and IDP.

8. The agency ensure that required Aging Aircraft inspections be considered inherently governmental.

PASS looks forward to our negotiating over the impact of this Order.
