Safety at Work

- The FAA must comply with all applicable federal regulations related to occupational safety and health.
- The FAA must also continue involvement in the Occupational Safety, Health, and Environmental Compliance Committee (OSHECCOM).
- General duty clause: The FAA must make every reasonable effort to provide and maintain safe and healthful working conditions.

Safety Representatives

- PASS is permitted to designate a full-time national safety representative to serve on the national OSHECCOM as well as a point of contact for all national-level occupational safety and health issues and other related matters.
- PASS is permitted to designate one representative for each of the agency's regions. These reps will represent the union at their respective regional level OSHECCOM and will serve as regional points of contact.
