The New Top 9 Organizations

REPORT TO THE ADMINISTRATOR

ATO	Air Traffic Organization Delivers safe, efficient air traffic services nationwide; transfers Program Management to AMO and other functions to ASM/AIT.
AMO	Airspace Modernization Office Leads NAS modernization and the \$12.5B BNATCS program; combines legacy NextGen (ARD) and ATO's Program Management Office.
AFO	Administration & Finance Office FAA's shared administrative services provider for finance, IT, HR, and civil rights; consolidates AFN, AHR, and ACR under the CAO.
ASE	Strategy & Engagement Org. (formerly ALO) Oversees policy, legal, and stakeholder engagement; consolidates Chief Counsel, Airports, Rulemaking, Gov't Affairs, and Communications.
ASM	Aviation Safety Management Office Centralizes safety management activities agency-wide, drawing safety and investigative functions from across former lines of business.

REPORT TO THE DEPUTY ADMINISTRATOR

AVS	Aviation Safety Oversight & Certification Org. Continues aerospace safety oversight & certification, now including hazmat safety; transfers UAS to AAT and Rulemaking to ASE.
AA AAT T	Office of Advanced Aviation Technologies FAA's focal point for civil & public drone integration and advanced aviation technologies; built from the legacy UAS Integration Office.
ASH	Security & Intelligence Organization Leads FAA security & intelligence activities, now including investigative functions from AAE; transfers Hazmat Safety to AVS.
AST	Commercial Space Transportation Regulates the U.S. commercial space transportation industry; realigned under the Deputy Administrator, structure largely unchanged.
